Linda O. asks for prayers for Dave's brother Larry, who had what appears to be a stroke.


Linda H. asks for prayers for a Zoom Council meeting with open ears, open minds and open hearts.

The Zoom Council meeting was held on Sunday, November 15. Detailed minutes will be available in next week's Chimes. Briefly, a motion to delay approving the revised MCoB constitution until it is possible for the congregation to meet in person and discuss the changes in more detail was approved. The budget was approved with a change to the Witness budget to maintain last year's level of support to Bethany Seminary. The slate of 2021 commission personnel was approved, as were the 2021 Deacons.
